Q: "Can I have both Medicare and Medicaid?"

A: Yes! Medicare and Medicaid are two separate, government-run programs. They are operated and funded by different parts of the government and primarily serve different groups.

• If you are eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid (dually eligible), you can have both. They will work together to provide you with health coverage and lower your costs.

Also know that while Medicare and Medicaid are both health insurance programs administered by the government, there are differences in covered services and cost-sharing. To see if you qualify for Medicaid, Call Friends for Life Medicaid Consultants at (516)900-1818.

Chicken Tacos with Pineapple Salsa

Directions

1. Cut chicken into small strips*



15 MINUTES

COOK TIME

10 MINUTES

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound boneless skinless chicken (or chicken thighs)
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 lime juice of lime
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic salt
- 1/2 teaspoon cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon chili powder
- 1/2 teaspoon paprika
- For the pineapple salsa
- 1 cup fresh pineapple chopped
- 1/4 large red onion finely chopped
- 1/2 cup fresh cilantro chopped
- 1/2 lime juice of 1/2 lime
- 1/2 jalapeno finely chopped (seeds removed if you don't like it too spicy)
- dash of salt
- taco shells

- 2. Put chicken in a bowl and add all ingredients (olive oil, juice of 1 lime, salt, garlic salt, cumin, chili powder, paprika) and stir to combine. Let sit for 5 minutes (or marinate up to overnight in the fridge.)
- 3. While chicken is resting, make the pineapple salsa.
- Combine fresh pineapple pieces, chopped red onion, cilantro, juice of 1/2 of a lime, jalapeno and a pinch of salt. Stir to combine, and put salsa in the fridge while cooking the chicken.
- Cook the chicken in acast iron skillet over high heat, allow chicken to brown before flipping it (about 3 minutes per side).*
- 6. Warm tacos according to package instructions & Assemble your tacos!



Huge "Community Medicaid" Cuts It is essential to "plan" NOW more than ever

Beginning October 1, 2020, the new Medicaid rules will require a full review of an individual's finances, going back to October 1, 2020 transfers, eventually adding up to a two and a half year look-back.



THE PHASED IN SCHEDULE:

- Each month from 10/1/20, the look-back will add an extra month, requiring submission of records since 10/1/20. Transfers made BEFORE 10/1/20 will not have any penalty.
- If there were transfers of assets during that look-back period that are not "exempt" transfers, the individual will be denied Medicaid coverage of the long-term care services for a "penalty" period. The penalty period is still undetermined by New York State.

The usual "exempt" transfers still apply—transfers to the spouse, transfers by an individual under 65 to a supplemental needs trust. transfer to a disabled child.

The new plan is still rolling out changes, but here at Friends for Life Medicaid Consultants, we are staying fully informed of the changes as they come.
